FACT-CHECKING

✓ ALWAYS VERIFY THE INFORMATION FROM MULTIPLE RELIABLE SOURCES BEFORE PUBLISHING

✓ DOUBLE-CHECK

✓ DOUBLE-CHECK FACTS, FIGURES, AND QUOTES

✓ SOURCE CREDIBILITY

✓ USE REPUTABLE SOURCES

AVOID MISINFORMATION

✓ AVOID SPREADING MISINFORMATION

✓ BALANCE

NEUTRALITY

✓ STAY NEUTRAL AND AVOID PROMOTING PERSONAL OR ORGANIZATIONAL AGENDAS

✓ IMPARTIAL REPORTING

✓ MAINTAIN IMPARTIALITY IN REPORTING
