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# ETHICAL PUBLICATION – BEST PRACTICES

## RESEARCH AND VERIFICATION

### ✓ FACT-CHECKING

- ✓ ALWAYS VERIFY THE INFORMATION FROM MULTIPLE RELIABLE SOURCES BEFORE PUBLISHING

### ✓ DOUBLE-CHECK

- ✓ DOUBLE-CHECK FACTS, FIGURES, AND QUOTES

### ✓ SOURCE CREDIBILITY

- ✓ USE REPUTABLE SOURCES

### ✓ AVOID MISINFORMATION

- ✓ AVOID SPREADING MISINFORMATION



# ETHICAL PUBLICATION – BEST PRACTICES

## FAIRNESS AND IMPARTIALITY

### ✓ **BALANCE**

- ✓ PRESENT BALANCED VIEWPOINTS AND AVOID BIAS

### ✓ **FAIR REPRESENTATION**

- ✓ ENSURE THAT DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES ARE FAIRLY REPRESENTED

### ✓ **NEUTRALITY**

- ✓ STAY NEUTRAL AND AVOID PROMOTING PERSONAL OR ORGANIZATIONAL AGENDAS

### ✓ **IMPARTIAL REPORTING**

- ✓ MAINTAIN IMPARTIALITY IN REPORTING

## TRANSPARENCY AND DISCLOSURE

### ✓ CONFLICT OF INTEREST

- ✓ DISCLOSE ANY POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

### ✓ SPONSORSHIPS AND AFFILIATIONS

- ✓ DISCLOSE SPONSORSHIPS AND AFFILIATIONS

### ✓ FINANCIAL INTERESTS

- ✓ DISCLOSE FINANCIAL INTERESTS

### ✓ CORRECTIONS

- ✓ PROMPTLY CORRECT ERRORS AND INACCURACIES
