# CLINICAL DETAILS

5.6 Year old female baby with mother as informant has complaints of deformity of bilateral legs and inadequate growth since 4 years

## FINDINGS ARE AS FOLLOWS :

ulnar metaphysis Metaphyseal cupping and fraying noted Physeal widening shown as increased distance between epiphysis and metaphysis

### FINDINGS AT WRIST JOINT: Loss of definition of provisional zone of calcification in distal radial and





FINDINGS AT KNEE : Thinned out cortex Distal femoral and tibial physeal widening Bowing of femur and tibia Fraying , cupping, irregular metaphysis – giving appearance of paint brush pattern



FINDINGS AT KNEE JOINTS: Marked bowing of tibia and fibula bilaterally Metaphyseal cupping ,fraying Knock knee or genu valgum in relation to Long axis of femur –( physiological from 2 to 7 yrs) ILIOTIBIAL band contracture Subchondral sclerosis
