Patient Profile

Name: ABC

Age: 18 years

Sex: Male

Presenting Complaint: Sudden severe headache and vomiting

History of Presenting Illness:

An 18-year-old previously healthy male presented to the emergency department with a sudden onset of "worst headache of her life" that began 2 hours prior to admission. The headache was abrupt, severe, and diffuse, associated with nausea and vomiting

Past Medical History: No known chronic illnesses

No previous similar episodes

No history of seizures or hypertension

CT FINDINGS

- SAH noted along right sylvian fissure, ambient cistern and interhemispheric cistern.
- Focal outpouching noted arising from right ICA at the bifurcation into MCA and ACA. It measures ~ 8x7.6mm-->Berry aneurysm.

Impression: BERRY ANEURYSM OF RIGHT ICA AT THE BIFURCATION INTO MCA AND ACA.
